East Midlands Gateway

The project, East Midlands Gateway, aims to create 7000 new jobs and provides new rail and road connected distribution and storage facilities including;

- · An intermodal freight terminal
- Up to 557,414 m2 (6m sq ft) of rail served warehousing and ancillary service buildings;

- A new rail line connecting the terminal to the Castle Donnington - branch freight only line;

New road infrastructure and improvements to the existing road infrastructure on A453, A50

- Strategic landscaping and the creation of new publicly accessible open areas;
- Bus interchange on A453

Current Activities

Earthworks are progressing on site as programmed. Landscaping of flood protection bund to northern boundary is ongoing.

Church Street Lockington to close 2/10/17. Advance notice signage installed.

A453 Contraflow on North Bound. Drainage, street furniture ongoing on South Bound. Both directions to open on A453 week commencing 7th November 2017.

Junction 24 – Investigative survey works ongoing.

Junction 24a-A50 South bound earth works ongoing.

Installation of Rail Bridge on Main Street Lockington ongoing.

The A453 new access junction proceeding onto site with services installation.

Planned Activities

Works on the main site will continue in the same fashion. The A453 new access junction will proceed with services installation.

Junction 24a activities will involve earthworks including filling embankment to road level. Piling for bridge on A50 slip road and the creation of a wetland area.
