TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER

MELBOURNE ROAD **ISLEY WALTON, WILSON, CASTLE DONINGTON**

Leicestershire County Council Highways has agreed to a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order at the above location.

A road closure is required on Melbourne Road between Walton Hill and the County Boundary on the 23rd November 2020 for 11 days. Works are scheduled to take place weekdays only with the road opened at weekends.

The Temporary Traffic Regulation Order will be implemented for public safety for **Leicestershire County Council to facilitate carriageway patching**.

The proposed alternative diversion route will be via: Walton Hill, A453 From Walton Hill To Moor Lane, Isley Walton; From Main Street To Moor Lane, Main Street, Ashby Road, Breedon On The Hill; Nottingham Road, Worthington; Melbourne Road, Staunton Harold; B587 From Robinsons Hill To County Boundary (Woodhouses), Robinsons Hill, Cockshut Lane, Derby Road, Kings Newton Lane, Melbourne; Main Street, (Kings Newton), Melbourne; and vice versa.
