## TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER

## CEDAR ROAD, HASTINGS STREET; CASTLE DONINGTON

Leicestershire County Council Highways has agreed to a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order at the above location.

A prohibition of waiting and loading is required on the above locations (see plan) on the 11<sup>th</sup> January 2021 for approximately four weeks as follows:

- Cedar Road from 11<sup>th</sup> January 2021 for four days
- Hastings Street from 15<sup>th</sup> January 2021 for fourteen days

Restrictions will be in place Monday to Friday 09:00 to 15:00.

The Temporary Traffic Regulation Order will be implemented for public safety for Leicestershire County Council to facilitate carriageway patching.
