Kick Starting Coalville January 2021





Kick Start Scheme:

is helping young people at risk of long term unemployment get into the job market by providing government funding for employers to create six-month job placements.

The Kickstart Scheme provides funding to create new job placements for 16 to 24 year olds on Universal Credit who are at risk of long term unemployment.

Universal Credit

Only individuals on UC can apply. So if you aren't on it, and you could be, it might be worth applying.

Eligibility – there are some rules about eligibility eg if you have over 16k in savings you might not be eligible, and it takes into account what your partner earns. There are also extra rules for 16 or 17 year olds. Its worth checking and applying.

It takes up to 5 weeks to be approved, however once you are in it is an open and flexible system so if you move between jobs or start your business and your income goes up and down, you don't have to keep reapplying, your benefit adjusts.

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Gardener & Parks with NWL Veterans @ Coalville Park

Can you help? Are you interested in working in a local park alongside veterans, community groups and others in Coalville Park?

How the money works

Young people / employees get paid according to their age at minimum wage rate for 25 hours a week for 6 months under a contract of employment. All wages, pension and national insurance contributions are paid. So what does that look like?

For ages 16/17 - £4.55 per hour, £113.75 per wk (25 hours) & **£2,957.5** for the 6 mths

For ages 18-20 - £6.45 per hour, £161.25 per wk (25 hours) & £4,192.5 for the 6 mths

For ages 21-24 - £8.20 per hour, £205 per wk (25 hours) & £5,330 for the 6 mths

Reaching People (the organisation that's applied to DWP as the Gateway Provider) receive £300 per role for admin

THINK FC (as the employer) receives £1,500 per role for administration and support

Timescale

We hope that the roles will be advertised by mid Jan with a potential start date of Feb 1st.

This is not clear at the moment as all the placements need to go live on the UC system first.

This project finishes in December 2021 so there may be the chance of another round – so if there is something you really want to do, get in touch.

Process

All applications in the first instance need to go through the Work Coach at the Job Centre. They will match young people to placements.

(Young people can go direct to their Work Coach with an opportunity they want as soon as they are live on the UC system)

The applicant will get the placement details & application form in their UC account which they complete and send to TH!NK FC

Depending on the role TH!NK FC will share with partners

Selected applicants will be invited for an interview.

Application Form

All applications in the first instance will come to TH!NK FC and they will share with partners

The form will ask basic details:

The placement that you are applying for &

What is it about the placement that you like the sound of?

What reasons do you think that you would be good at it?

What are you looking forward to learning the most?

What are you looking forward to sharing the most?

What else can you tell us about yourself or your experiences that might be helpful to us?

DWP & Coalville Job Centre

The Work Coach has access to all the jobs on the UC Kick

Start system – they are only viewable by the Work Coach for them to share with their clients on the DWP system. This is to make sure that all eligibility requirements are met

(le on UC and 16-24)

We are planning to share all these jobs with the Work

Coaches at an upcoming meeting.

Support and Training

The programme includes support which will be provided by TH!NK FC and (possibly) some of the other Partners of Reaching People.

TH!NK FC will offer a sharing of the TH!NK Tool programme including providing a journal, resources and Thinking Kits for all.

All partners are expected to provide their own induction – and may include additional training.

Wherever possible the training and support young people need and want will be offered.

Apprenticeships and Courses

There may be some specific courses or opportunities that you are interested in that are free to attend.

Heather has offered to share these and support the sharing of them for any participant – and also for other partners, community groups and in the wider community.

Or Self Employment!

Or may be its starting your own business you are interested in – starting one can run along side this programme or be something you are aiming for afterwards.
