NOTIFICATION OF ESSENTIAL MAINTENANCE WORKS M1 Junction 23a – 23 Southbound

I'm writing to let you know that we'll be carrying out essential maintenance work on the M1 from Junction 23a to 23 southbound carriageway.

During our comprehensive scheme of work, which includes the A42 entry / exit slips, we will carry out resurfacing, refurbishment of bridge joints, road markings and road studs.

Once completed, all road users will benefit from improved road safety and a smoother driving experience.

When will the work take place?

Work is due to start **7 February 2022** and is scheduled for completion by **May 2022**.

We will work in phases between:

- **11pm and 5am Monday to Friday** on the M1 southbound carriageway
- **8pm and 6am Monday to Friday** on the M1 / A42 southbound exit slip road

During these hours we will put in place a full closure of the M1 southbound carriageway between Junction 23a and 23, including the southbound exit slip road, and A453 entry to M1 / A42 southbound at Junction 23a.

Please note that all our planned works are subject to change due to weather conditions, significant events or unforeseen circumstances.

How will the work affect traffic?

During full road closures, we will put in place fully signed diversion routes which have been agreed with the local authority. All carriageways, roundabouts and slip roads will be fully open throughout the daytime.

How will the work affect businesses and residents?

We will make sure that access to businesses and residencies is maintained wherever possible.
