TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER

Barroon, Borough Street, Clapgun Street, Hemington Hill, Hillside, The Hollow, Moira Dale; Castle Donington

Leicestershire County Council Highways has agreed to a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order at the above location.

Road closures, prohibition of waiting/loading, temporary suspension of one-way and an implementation of one-way is required on the 11th April 2022 for four days:

Road Closures:

- Borough Street (part), Barroon, Hillside, Hemington Hill, Moira Dale (at its junction with Barroon), The Hollow.

Temporary Prohibition of Waiting and Loading:

- Barroon, Church Lane, Clapgun Street (part of), The Hollow,

Temporary Suspension of One-Way

- Church Lane, Clapgun Street (part of),

Temporary Implementation of One-Way

- Hillside – from Borough Street to Station Road

The Temporary Traffic Regulation Order will be implemented for public safety for **Leicestershire County Council to facilitate carriageway patching**.

The proposed alternative diversion route will be signed on site.
