## ADVANCE NOTIFICATION OF CARRIAGEWAY WORKS

Leicestershire County Council is planning to carry out patching works on High Street, Bondgate, Park Lane and Delven Lane, Castle Donington. The works will be carried out in two phases to minimise disruption.

Phase 1:- Park Lane will be closed on Wednesday 5th and Thursday 6th April between 8.00am and 6.00pm. The road will be closed between the junctions of Bosworth Road and Pathfinder Way. Residential access will be restricted at times with no through route.

Phase 2:- Repairs works will be carried out on the junction of High Street, Bondgate, Park Lane and Delven Lane. The location and nature of this phase will necessitate overnight closures beginning on Tuesday 11th April until Friday 14th April 2023, closures will commence at 7.00pm until 6.00am each night. Please see the programme of works below:

- High Street will be closed from the junction of Bondgate up to No. 36 High Street.
- Bondgate will be closed from the junction of Market Street up to the junction of High Street.
- Delven Lane will be closed from the junction of Dovecote up to the junction of High Street
- Park Lane will be closed from the junction The Green up to the junction of High Street.

Bus services via Castle Donington will be required to the follow the diversion route and may be subject to delays. Please be advised that access is restricted to emergency vehicles during phase 2 of the works.

Pedestrian access will not be affected during this programme of works and where roads are closed, signed diversions will be in place.
