- Make sure you're registered to vote by Tuesday 18 June
- Check you've got photo I.D.
- If you don't have photo I.D. apply for a Voter Authority Certificate by Wed 26 June
- Want to vote by post? Apply before Wed 19 June
- Want someone to vote on your behalf? Apply to vote by proxy. Deadline for registration is 5pm on Wed 26 June
- Do you vote in Oakthorpe and Donisthorpe, or Appleby? Please note, your parliamentary constituency has changed.

ACRE Village Hall Grants

Village Hall management committees can apply once again for larger grants to improve their buildings. ACRE can provide grants of up to £75,000 to support larger improvement projects to rural community buildings such as full refits and extensions.

Funding for Places Grants' Programme

The Wolfson Foundation funds a broad range of organisations working across the fields of education, science and medicine, health and disability, heritage and arts and humanities. Grants vary but start at £15,000 with some up to £500,000. Deadline for applications is Monday 1 July.

People's Health Trust

Grants of between £20,000 and £40,000 are available for projects that support people's mental and physical health by accessing advice. Applications are encouraged from grassroots community organisations. Deadline for applications is 3pm on Wednesday 19 June.

Warburtons Community Grants

Grants of up to £400 are available to not-for-profit organisations for projects that address one of three priority areas: Health, Place and Skills. Deadline for applications is Monday 5 August.

Esmée Fairbairn Collections Fund

Grants of between £40,000 and £100,000 for up to three years are available to museums and galleries. Deadline for applications is Monday 16 September.
