Temporary Traffic Regulation Order

From The Green To Unnamed At Top Merrill, Long Whatton and Dlseworth

Leicestershire County Council Highways has agreed to a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order at the above location.

The Temporary Traffic Regulation Order will be implemented for public safety for **CPC Civils for Severn Trent Water to facilitate installation of new sewer pipeline.**

A road closure is required on "From The Green To Unnamed At Top Merrill" from its junction with Gelscoe Lane for approximately 250 metres heading north on the 24th June 2024 for four weeks.

Due to unforeseen ground conditions and additional requests from National Highways works have been extended by a further two weeks and are anticipated to be completed by 4th August 2024.

Due to the location of the installation and excavation size, emergency services access will not be maintained through the works area.

The proposed alternative diversion route will be via: Gelscoe Lane, A453 Moor Lane, Breedon On The Hill; A453 from Walton Hill to Moor Lane, Walton Hill, Isley Cum Langley; Ashby Road, From Green Lane to Ashby Road, Castle Donington; The Green, Long Whatton; and vice versa.
