

#### The Town of Two Fathers Heritage Trail



Coalville did not exist before 1830. The area was known as Long Lane and was part of the parishes of Hugglescote, Snibston, Swannington and Whitwick. The creation of Coalville was due to three men: William Stenson, George and Robert Stephenson. This trail tells the town's story.
