Temporary Traffic Regulation Order

Kegworth Bypass, Kegworth

Leicestershire County Council Highways has agreed to a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order at the above location.

The Temporary Traffic Regulation Order will be implemented for public safety for **National Highways to facilitate urgent carriageway repairs and railing replacement following a road traffic collision.**

A road closure is required on Kegworth Bypass on the 28th September 2024 for **TWO** nights between 20:00 and 05:00 as follows:

- Eastbound from A453 to Ashby Road
- Westbound all traffic will need to turn left onto the A453 South towards Finger Farm Roundabout/Donington Services

All traffic exiting Wilders Way (East Midlands Gateway) will have to turn left towards M1 J24a

Please note these works involve the closure of National Highways roads including A453 southbound from J24a to Kegworth Bypass, lane restrictions/closures on the A453/A6/East Midlands Gateway Roundabout, and lane closures on A453 northbound and southbound.

The proposed alternative diversion routes will be signed on site.
